Profile - Deacon Jose

Brothers and sisters in Christ,

It is with abundant joy, considerable anticipation, and thankful praise to our God, that I begin ordained ministry to the people of God within the Diocese of Fresno. St. Antony of Padua's welcoming and faith-filled community has been a very special part of my family's life for 12 years. My wife Eliana and 3 kids, Sebastian (12), Emma (10), and Abraham (2 months) have been blessed to be part of this community and have felt the love and inclusive Eucharistic unity within the parish.

I was born in Mexico City, but have lived in Fresno for the majority of my life. My mother, Maria Ordaz lives here as well and is a parishioner at St. John's Cathedral. I have two siblings, my older brother Heriberto, and Sister Griselda who also live in Fresno. Our mother's faith is the reason by which we learned that God's mercy is the foundation of life and the fountain of grace. We received the majority of our initial sacraments in Mexico, but my mother made sure we went to Mass every Sunday and with her limitations but great example showed us how to pray and love God.

I have been blessed by God in many ways. He has been working on me and has called me constantly throughout my life. As a kid I was part of missionary parish outreach in Mexico and as a teenager I was part of various youth groups at St. John's Cathedral. In a spiritual retreat, I felt the calling to religious life and I joined The Institute of The Incarnated Word. As a missionary I

When I came back to Fresno I rejoined the youth groups and young adults as a coordinator; it was there I met my wife Eliana and got married. Through prayer and spiritual direction from our priests here at St Antony I felt and discerned the call to sacred orders in the ministry of the Diaconate. With the support and guidance of our pastor, Msgr. Rob, my wife, and our Bishop, I went through the program and have been ordained to our diocese and our parish.

I rely on the love and grace of Almighty God and trust in His plan for His servant. I trust myself to your prayers, good will, cordial patience and genuine charity as I begin my diaconal service. May I be a good steward of God's love and serve you like Christ, the servant of all.
