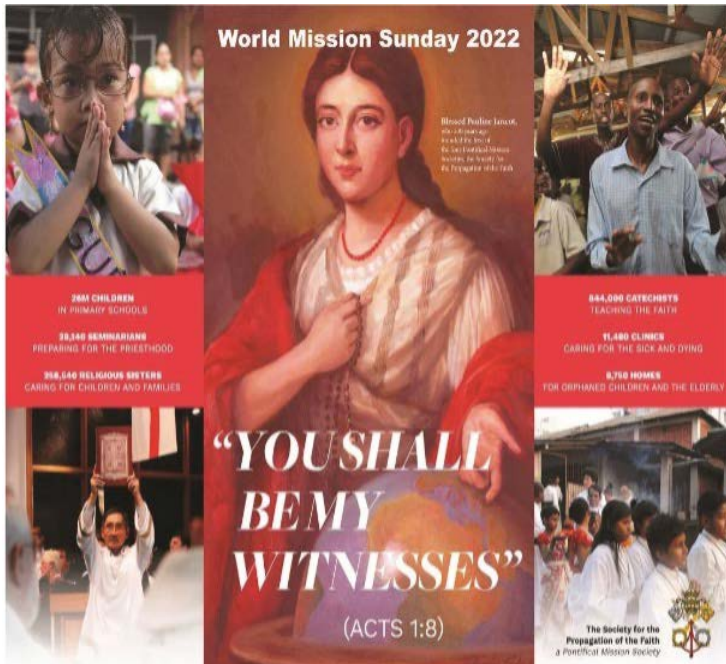

Ministry Profile – Usher and Greeter Ministry

He said, "I think I want to Usher, too." I said, "Eureka!" "I had always wished you would." I captured a photo of his first day in Ushering attire.

It is a voluntary commitment to serve the community, our church, our brothers and sisters in Christ. In reality we are blessed with the unique opportunity to serve. Being there at every Mass, being with Him, feeling His real presence, His Love, His message, directly from Him through Him and through the blessed clergy. Prayers answered, prayers offered, songs and psalms, seeing the community support of one another during loss, sickness and celebrations. His love poured unto us and all our Church family. That Holy flame in us, the Holy Spirit will never extinguish, because it is Himself, The Almighty, who dwells in us. Our Holy Spirit flame just grows happier when we serve, especially together in any church ministry. – Together in Christ, The Gonzalez Innis family.

A LIFE OF PRAYER

Reflection on Luke 18:1-8

We are presented in these readings with Moses, a great leader of his people, and a nameless woman who is a disenfranchised widow on the margins of society. Both are pleading for something they dearly want. It would be easy to reduce these stories to the lesson that if we are persistent in prayer, God will give us what we ask for.

There is something deeper here. Toward the end of the Gospel story, Jesus refers to, "his chosen ones who call out to him day and night." This is something more than persistence. It calls us to choose a lifestyle of prayer; to experience prayer not as something we do, or an accomplishment, but as a state of being. Prayer is the awareness of God in everything, engagement with God in all of life, and ultimately prayer is abandonment to God.

Calling out to God day and night, we embrace prayer as a way of life that is as natural as breathing. The persistence that is recommended by Jesus will transform us, so that in the end, it is not what I want or desire that is important, but rather what God wills.

UNA VIDA DE ORACIÓN

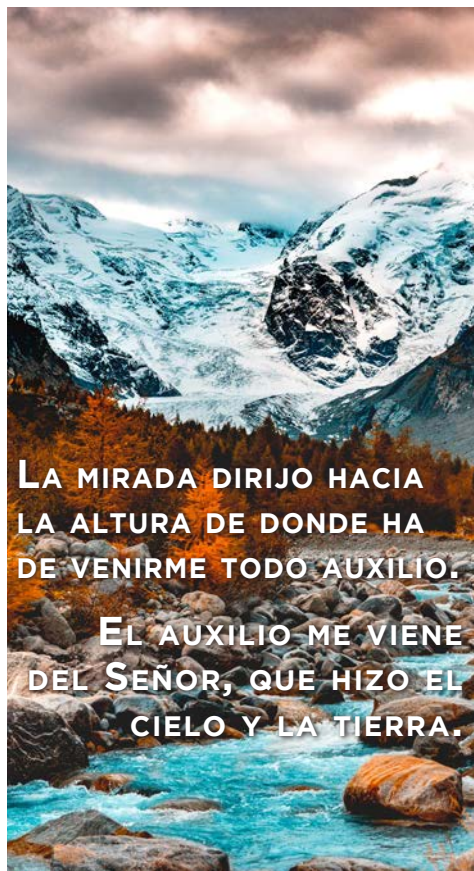
Reflexión sobre Lucas 18,1-8

En estas lecturas se nos presenta a Moisés, un gran líder de su pueblo, y a una mujer sin nombre que es una viuda marginada en los márgenes de la sociedad. Ambos suplican por algo que desean profundamente. Sería fácil reducir estas historias a la lección de que si somos persistentes en la oración, Dios nos dará lo que pedimos.

Pero hay algo más profundo. Hacia el final del relato evangélico, Jesús se refiere a "sus elegidos que le invocan día y noche". Esto es algo más que persistencia. Nos llama a elegir un estilo de vida de oración; a experimentar la oración no como algo que hacemos, o un logro, sino como un estado de ser. La oración es la conciencia de Dios en todo, el compromiso con Dios en toda la vida y, en última instancia, la oración es el abandono en Dios.

Invocando a Dios día y noche, abrazamos la oración como una forma de vida que es tan natural como respirar. La persistencia recomendada por Jesús nos transformará, de modo que al final, lo importante no es lo que yo quiero o deseo, sino lo que Dios quiere.

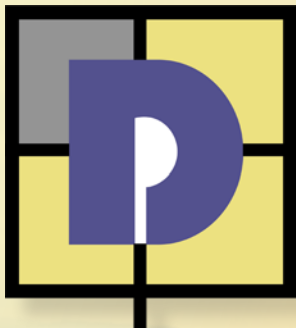
