## WITH US UNTIL THE END

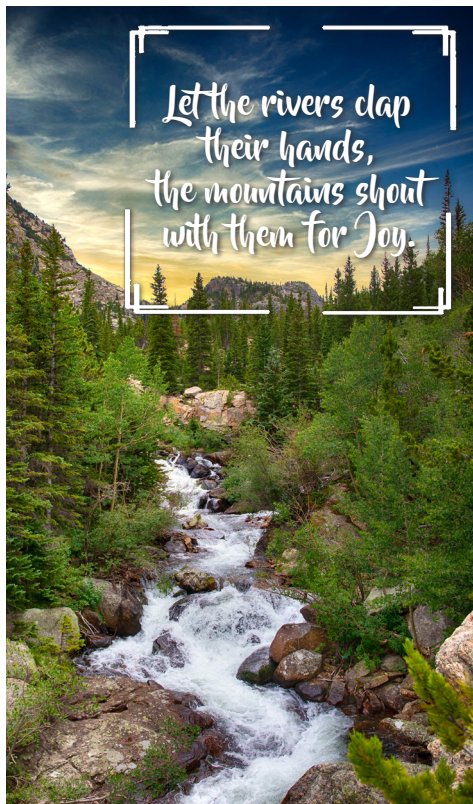
*Reflection on Luke 21:5-19*

The temple, a symbol of God's presence on earth and of His covenant with the Israelites, was totally destroyed ("the days will come when there will not be left a stone upon another stone that will not be thrown down") during the destruction of Jerusalem by the Romans in 70 C.E. Luke's Gospel was written sometime in the 80's, and I wonder if the impact of this on the Jewish world at the time was similar to the shock on 9/11 in our time. Certainly, Luke's hearers were experiencing a time of great national distress.

The apocalyptic imagery used here is certainly distressing, but this passage and others like it are not predictive, revealing what is to come, but rather reveal to us what is now the case. Jesus is not so much speaking about the end of times, but about the condition of every time, in this in-between time.

The important message is perseverance and endurance, clinging to the promise of Jesus to be with us always, even to the end of the age. Though temples fall and wars and persecutions rage, "...not a hair on your head will be destroyed. By your perseverance you will secure your lives."

## SAINT MARGARET OF SCOTLAND

*Feast Day: November 16*

*Patron Saint of: Service to the poor*

Not Scottish by birth, Margaret was the daughter of Princess Agatha of Hungary and the Anglo-Saxon Prince Edward Atheling. Her family fled from William the Conqueror and was shipwrecked off the coast of Scotland. King Malcolm befriended them and was captivated by the beautiful, gracious Margaret. They were married at the castle of Dunfermline in 1070.

Malcolm was good-hearted, but rough and uncultured, as was his country. Because of Malcolm's love for Margaret, she was able to soften his temper, polish his manners, and help him become a virtuous king. He left all domestic affairs to her, and often consulted her in state matters.

Margaret tried to improve her adopted country by promoting the arts and education. For religious reform she encouraged synods and was present for the discussions which tried to correct religious abuses common among priests. With her husband, she founded several churches.

She had certain times for prayer and reading Scripture. She ate sparingly and slept little in order to have time for devotions. She and Malcolm kept two Lents, one before Easter and one before Christmas. During these times she always rose at midnight for Mass. On the way home she would wash the feet of six poor persons and give them alms. She was always surrounded by beggars in public and never refused them. It is recorded that she never sat down to eat without first feeding nine orphans and 24 adults.

Margaret's outstanding virtue was her love of the poor. Although very generous with material gifts, Margaret also visited the sick and nursed them with her own hands.

## SANTA MARGARITA DE ESCOCIA

Día de la fiesta: 16 de noviembre

Patrona de: El servicio a los pobres

No es escocesa de nacimiento, Margarita era hija de la princesa Ágata de Hungría y del príncipe anglosajón Eduardo Atheling. Su familia huyó de Guillermo el Conquistador y naufragó frente a las costas de Escocia. El rey Malcolm se hizo amigo de ellos y quedó cautivado por la bella y graciosa Margarita. Se casaron en el castillo de Dunfermline en 1070.

Malcolm tenía buen corazón, pero era rudo e inculto, como su país. Gracias al amor de Malcolm por Margarita, ella pudo suavizar su temperamento, pulir sus modales y ayudarlo a convertirse en un rey virtuoso. Le dejaba todos los asuntos domésticos a ella, y a menudo la consultaba en asuntos de estado.

Margarita trató de mejorar su país de adopción promoviendo las artes y la educación. Para la reforma religiosa fomentó los sínodos y estuvo presente en las discusiones que intentaban corregir los abusos religiosos comunes entre los sacerdotes. Con su marido, fundó varias iglesias.

Tenía ciertos horarios para la oración y la lectura de las Escrituras. Comía poco y dormía poco para tener tiempo para las devociones. Ella y Malcolm celebraban dos cuaresmas, una antes de Pascua y otra antes de Navidad. Durante estas épocas siempre se levantaba a medianoche para ir a misa. De vuelta a casa, lavaba los pies a seis pobres y les daba limosna. Siempre estaba rodeada de mendigos en público y nunca los rechazaba. Consta que nunca se sentaba a comer sin antes dar de comer a nueve huérfanos y 24 adultos.

La virtud más destacada de Margarita era su amor por los pobres. Aunque era muy generosa con los regalos materiales, Margarita también visitaba a los enfermos y los cuidaba con sus propias manos.

## CON NOSOTROS HASTA EL FINAL

Reflexión sobre Lucas 21:5-19

El templo, símbolo de la presencia de Dios en la tierra y de su alianza con los israelitas, fue totalmente destruido ("vendrán días en que no quedará piedra sobre piedra que no sea derribada") durante la destrucción de Jerusalén por los romanos en el año 70 E.C. El Evangelio de Lucas fue escrito en algún momento de la década de los 80, y me pregunto si el impacto de este hecho en el mundo judío de entonces fue similar a la conmoción del 11 de septiembre en nuestra época. Ciertamente, los oyentes de Lucas estaban experimentando una época de gran angustia nacional.

Las imágenes apocalípticas utilizadas aquí son ciertamente angustiosas, pero este pasaje y otros similares no son predictivos, revelando lo que está por venir, sino que nos revelan lo que es ahora. Jesús no habla tanto del fin de los tiempos, sino de la condición de cada tiempo, en este tiempo intermedio.

El mensaje importante es la perseverancia y la resistencia, aferrándose a la promesa de Jesús de estar siempre con nosotros, incluso hasta el fin de los tiempos. Aunque los templos caigan y las guerras y persecuciones hagan estragos, "...ni un pelo de vuestra cabeza será destruido. Con vuestra perseverancia aseguraréis vuestras vidas."

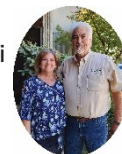

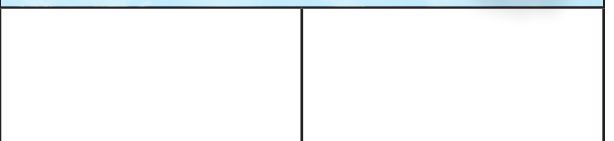

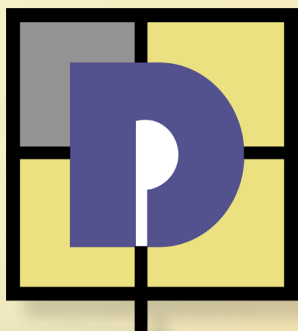
