

HOLY EUCHARIST

Reflection on John 6:51-58

I am Christian because of Jesus Christ. I am Catholic because of the Holy Eucharist. I just cannot imagine a journey through this life without the nourishment of the most holy Body and Blood of Christ every Sunday, indeed most days of the week as well.

In over thirty years of ministry with men and women converting to the Catholic faith, I have experienced that the one constant and common desire in all of them is a hunger for the Eucharist. Cradle Catholics who have grown complacent about the Eucharist or have become casual in their reception of the Eucharist would do well to walk with these catechumens as they prepare for the initiation sacraments. So often I have been enriched and renewed by their deep faith.

In these days of Eucharistic Revival in the Church, all Catholics are invited to remember that what we do in memory of Jesus, in receiving the Eucharist, is a sacramental obligation, a sacred responsibility that compels us not only to adoration, but to work on behalf of justice for the coming of God's kingdom.

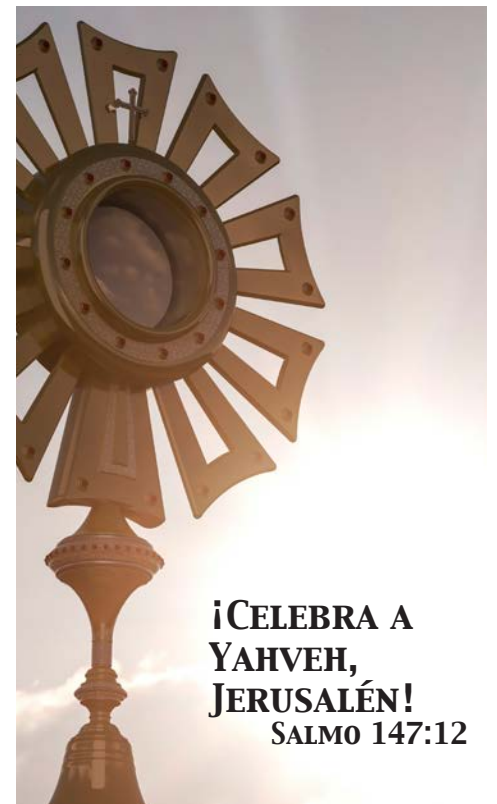

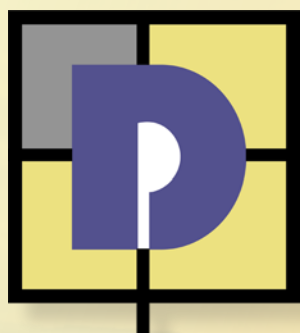
