## WHO AM I?

Reflection on Matthew 16:13-20

Today's Gospel presents us with one of the central questions of our lives as Jesus asks: "Who do you say that I am?" There are so many answers that one can give: Lord, Savior, friend, teacher, Redeemer, confidant, brother, healer, Son of the Living God, Light of the World, the Christ. At one time or another in our lives, even in the course of any given day, one of these might surface as central in our relationship with Jesus.

Let us also consider that when addressing this question of Jesus' identity, we are also answering the question, "Who am I?" What do I believe? What do I stand for? Where is the North on my compass? What do I place at the center of my life?

When Peter confesses that Jesus is the Christ in answer to the question, Jesus then renames Peter, giving him a new identity and a new purpose. The same can happen to us, if we allow it. Jesus can re-name us, re-direct our passions, give us new understanding, renew in us clean hearts and the desire to follow Him wherever He might lead.

## THE PASSION OF SAINT JOHN THE BAPTIST

Feast Day: August 29

Patron Saint of: builders and tailors

The drunken oath of a king with a shallow sense of honor, a seductive dance and the hateful heart of a queen combined to bring about the martyrdom of John the Baptist. The greatest of prophets suffered the fate of so many Old Testament prophets before him: rejection and martyrdom. The "voice crying in the desert" did not hesitate to accuse the guilty, did not hesitate to speak the truth. But why? What possesses a man that he would give up his very life?

This great religious reformer was sent by God to prepare the people for the Messiah. His vocation was one of selfless giving. The only power that he claimed was the Spirit of Yahweh. "I am baptizing you with water, for repentance, but the one who is coming after me is mightier than I. I am not worthy to carry his sandals. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire" (Matthew 3:11).

Scripture tells us that many people followed John looking to him for hope, perhaps in anticipation of some great messianic power. John never allowed himself the false honor of receiving these people for his own glory. He knew his calling was one of preparation. When the time came, he led his disciples to Jesus: "The next day John was there again with two of his disciples, and as he watched Jesus walk by, he said, 'Behold, the Lamb of God.' The two disciples heard what he said and followed Jesus" (John 1:35-37).

It is John the Baptist who has pointed the way to Christ. John's life and death were a giving over of self for God and other people. His simple style of life was one of complete detachment from earthly possessions. His heart was centered on God and the call that he heard from the Spirit of God speaking to his heart. Confident of God's grace, he had the courage to speak words of condemnation, repentance, and salvation.

El Evangelio de hoy nos presenta una de las preguntas centrales de nuestra vida cuando Jesús pregunta: "¿Quién decís que soy yo?" Son muchas las respuestas que uno puede dar: Señor, Salvador, amigo, maestro, Redentor, confidente, hermano, sanador, Hijo del Dios vivo, Luz del mundo, el Cristo. En un momento u otro de nuestras vidas, incluso en el transcurso de un día cualquiera, alguna de ellas puede aparecer como central en nuestra relación con Jesús.

Consideremos también que, al abordar esta cuestión de la identidad de Jesús, estamos respondiendo también a la pregunta: "¿Quién soy yo?" ¿En qué creo? ¿Qué definiendo? ¿Dónde está el Norte en mi brújula? ¿Qué pongo en el centro de mi vida?

Cuando Pedro confiesa que Jesús es el Cristo en respuesta a la pregunta, Jesús cambia el nombre de Pedro, dándole una nueva identidad y un nuevo propósito. Lo mismo puede ocurrirnos a nosotros, si lo permitimos. Jesús puede cambiarnos el nombre, redirigir nuestras pasiones, darnos un nuevo entendimiento, renovar en nosotros corazones limpios y el deseo de seguirle a donde Él nos lleve.

## LA PASIÓN DE SAN JUAN BAUTISTA

Festividad: 29 de agosto

Patrón de: constructores y sastres

El juramento ebrio de un rey con un sentido superficial del honor, una danza seductora y el corazón odioso de una reina se combinaron para provocar el martirio de Juan el Bautista. El más grande de los profetas sufrió el destino de tantos profetas del Antiguo Testamento antes que él: el rechazo y el martirio. La "voz que clama en el desierto" no dudó en acusar a los culpables, no dudó en decir la verdad. Pero, ¿por qué? ¿Qué posee a un hombre para que entregue su propia vida?

Este gran reformador religioso fue enviado por Dios para preparar al pueblo para el Mesías. Su vocación era la entrega desinteresada. El único poder que reclamaba era el Espíritu de Yahvé. "Yo os bautizo en agua para que os arrepintáis, pero el que viene detrás de mí es más poderoso que yo. Él os bautizará con Espíritu Santo y fuego" (Mateo 3,11).

La Escritura nos dice que mucha gente seguía a Juan en busca de esperanza, a la vez en previsión de algún gran poder mesiánico. Juan nunca se permitió el falso honor de recibir a estas personas para su propia gloria. Sabía que su vocación era de preparación. Cuando llegó el momento, condujo a sus discípulos hasta Jesús: "Al día siguiente, Juan estaba de nuevo allí con dos de sus discípulos y, al ver pasar a Jesús, dijo: 'He aquí el Cordero de Dios'. Los dos discípulos oyeron lo que decía y siguieron a Jesús" (Jn 1,35-37).

Es Juan el Bautista quien ha señalado el camino a Cristo. La vida y la muerte de Juan fueron una entrega de sí mismo a Dios y a los demás. Su estilo de vida sencillo era de desprendimiento total de las posesiones terrenales. Su corazón estaba centrado en Dios y en la llamada que oía del Espíritu de Dios que le hablaba al corazón. Confiado en la gracia de Dios, tuvo el valor de pronunciar palabras de condenación, arrepentimiento y salvación.

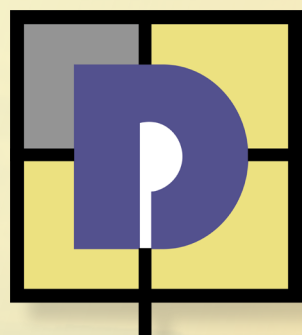
