Sisters and Brothers,

What is it about Easter Sunday that brings us such much joy and anticipation?

For many, the empty tomb represents their outlook on the life and their surroundings. For them, Easter morning and the empty tomb brings no sign of hope or joy.

As children, Easter is marked with Easter egg hunts, baskets, and the gathering of family and friends for a special Easter dinner. As adults, what is it that keeps the excitement and anticipation of Easter going for us?

Could it be that on Easter Sunday we make it a point to gather as a family for Mass? Could it be that on Easter Sunday we pause from the busyness of life

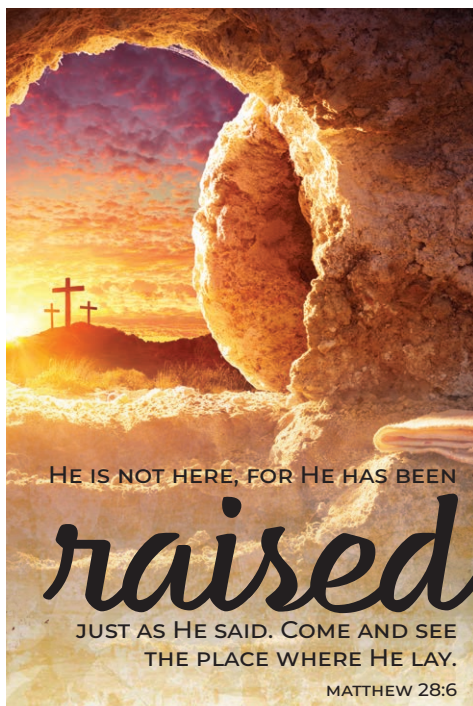
Reflection on Mark 14:1–15:47

God is Light! In God there is no darkness!

The resurrection opens up a new world for us. If God is Love, if the very source of existence is nothing but light, then our world which is so characterized by the shadows of violence, hatred, retribution, and the inability to forgive, is itself the illusion, the shadow. And we who belong to Christ are the lights to show that darkness for what it is, we are the heralds of a new way of being.

At the Easter Vigil celebration on Holy Saturday evening, we welcome those who, through baptism and profession of faith, through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit in the sacrament of confirmation, and by joining us for the first time at the Lord’s Eucharistic table, have been on a long journey to the Catholic Church. The Church now calls them neophytes – New Lights. They are living and breathing symbols of this new way of life made possible by Christ’s resurrection. And all of us, in renewing our baptismal vows, are asked to say NO to the shadows and darkneses of vengeance, violence and sin, and YES to the light we are called to be through the power of Christ’s resurrection. May we work with Christ to dispel the darkness in this world with the Light of love we have been given.

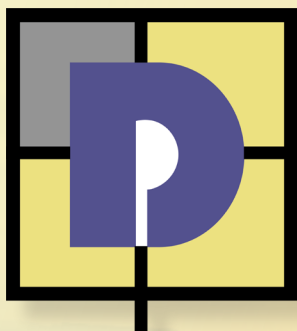
