## RHYTHMS

*Reflection on Mark 4:26-34*

Farmers and gardeners know that in the mystery of their efforts in the fields and in gardens, there is a certain rhythm at work. Preparing the soil, planting the seed, feeding and pruning, and harvesting – all by the grace of soil, sun and water – and the attention of the worker.

So the Church recognizes a certain rhythm in the mystery of evangelization, catechesis, and mission. There are certain steps to accomplish before others can be effective in the spread of the Gospel and the making of disciples. Liturgical processes like the Catechumenate, the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults, and faith formation programs like Alpha, take these rhythms into account.

Ultimately, however, and to change the metaphor: "If the Lord does not build the house, in vain do the builders labor." In other words, all of our efforts in the church at planting and harvesting – educating and forming – making disciples – must be accomplished through prayer and the mysterious grace of God at work in us.

## SAINT JOHN FRANCIS REGIS

*Saint of the Day: June 16*

*Patron Saint of: Lacemakers, Medical Social Workers, and Children Who are Born Outside of Marriage and Family.*

Following his ordination to the priesthood, John Francis undertook missionary work in various French towns. While the formal sermons of the day tended toward the poetic, his discourses were plain. But they revealed the fervor within him and attracted people of all classes. Father Regis especially made himself available to the poor. Many mornings were spent in the confessional or at the altar celebrating Mass; afternoons were reserved for visits to prisons and hospitals.

Though Father Regis longed to work as a missionary among the Native Americans in Canada, he was to live out his days working for the Lord in the wildest and most desolate part of his native France. There he encountered rigorous winters, snowdrifts and other deprivations. Meanwhile he continued preaching missions and earned a reputation as a saint. Upon entering the town of Saint-Andé, one man came upon a large crowd in front of a church and was told that people were waiting for "the saint" who was coming to preach a mission.

The last four years of his life were spent preaching and organizing social services, especially for prisoners, the sick and the poor. In the autumn of 1640, Father Regis sensed that his days were coming to a conclusion. He settled some of his affairs and prepared for the end by continuing to do what he did so well: speaking to the people about the God who loved them. On December 31, he spent most of the day with his eyes on the crucifix. That evening, he died. His final words were: "Into thy hands I commend my spirit."

John Francis Regis was canonized in 1737.

## SANTOS: JUAN FRANCISCO REGIS

*Santo del día: 16 de junio*

*Patrón de: Encajeras, Trabajadores Sociales Médicos y Niños Nacidos Fuera del Matrimonio y la Familia.*

Tras su ordenación sacerdotal, Juan Francisco emprendió una labor misionera en varias ciudades francesas. Mientras que los sermones formales de la época tendían a lo poético, sus discursos eran sencillos. Pero revelaban el fervor que llevaba dentro y atraían a gentes de todas las clases. El Padre Regis se puso especialmente a disposición de los pobres. Pasaba muchas mañanas en el confesionario o en el altar celebrando misa; las tardes las reservaba para visitar cárceles y hospitales.

Aunque el Padre Regis anhelaba trabajar como misionero entre los nativos americanos en Canadá, iba a vivir sus días trabajando para el Señor en la parte más salvaje y desolada de su Francia natal. Allí se encontró con inviernos rigurosos, ventisqueros y otras privaciones. Mientras tanto, siguió predicando misiones y se ganó fama de santo. Al entrar en la ciudad de Saint-Andé, un hombre se encontró con una gran multitud delante de una iglesia y le dijeron que la gente estaba esperando al «santo», que venía a predicar una misión.

Los últimos cuatro años de su vida los pasó predicando y organizando servicios sociales, especialmente para los presos, los enfermos y los pobres. En otoño de 1640, el padre Regis sintió que sus días llegaban a su fin. Arregló algunos de sus asuntos y se preparó para el final continuando haciendo lo que tan bien sabía hacer: hablar a la gente del Dios que la amaba. El 31 de diciembre, pasó la mayor parte del día con los ojos fijos en el crucifijo. Esa noche murió. Sus últimas palabras fueron: "En tus manos encomiendo mi espíritu."
