## TEMPTATION


*Reflection on Matthew 4:1-11*

Matthew moves from Jesus' Baptism, where He was named God's Son, the Beloved, immediately to His journey of temptation in the desert, where He will be tested in His fidelity to this identity just revealed in the Jordan river. Matthew tells us that Jesus was "led by the Spirit into the desert," which seems to me a holy promise that, no matter where we find ourselves, no matter how fast our circumstances may change (from Baptism – a spiritual high, to temptation – a difficult low), the Spirit of God never leaves our side.

In stark contrast to Adam and Eve's response to caving in to the devil's temptation in the Creation story, Jesus' reaction is steadfast in His fidelity to live only in the fullness of life that comes from union with God. Through Adam, we inherit sin; through Jesus, we are given freedom and life.

Lent, as a time of repentance, urges us to confront these same temptations Jesus confronted – food, safety, and power. We encounter versions of these all the time, and the temptation is to allow them to hold a central place in our lives, where they can take root and crowd out of our hearts the room that is only truly filled and fed in surrender to God.

## SAINT GABRIEL OF OUR LADY OF SORROWS

*Saint of the Day: February 21*

*Patron Saint of Clergy, Students and Young People*

Born in Italy into a large family and baptized Francis, Saint Gabriel lost his mother when he was only four years old. He was educated by the Jesuits and, having been cured twice of serious illnesses, came to believe that God was calling him to the religious life. Young Francis wished to join the Jesuits but was turned down, probably because of his age, not yet 17. Following the death of a sister to cholera, his resolve to enter religious life became even stronger and he was accepted by the Passionists. Upon entering the novitiate, he was given the name Gabriel of Our Lady of Sorrows.

Ever popular and cheerful, Gabriel quickly was successful in his effort to be faithful in little things. His spirit of prayer, love for the poor, consideration of the feelings of others, exact observance of the Passionist Rule as well as his bodily penances – always subject to the will of his wise superiors – made a deep impression on everyone.

His superiors had great expectations of Gabriel as he prepared for the priesthood, but after only four years of religious life, symptoms of tuberculosis appeared. Ever obedient, he patiently bore the painful effects of the disease and the restrictions it required, seeking no special notice. He died peacefully on February 27, 1862, at age 24, having been an example to both young and old.

Saint Gabriel of Our Lady of Sorrows was canonized in 1920.

When we think of achieving great holiness by doing little things with love and grace, Therese of Lisieux comes first to mind. Like her, Gabriel died painfully from tuberculosis. Together they urge us to tend to the small details of daily life, to be considerate of others' feelings every day. Our path to sanctity, like theirs, probably lies not in heroic doings but in performing small acts of kindness every day.

## TENTACIÓN


Reflexión sobre Mateo 4:1-11

Mateo pasa del bautismo de Jesús, donde fue nombrado Hijo de Dios, el Amado, inmediatamente a su viaje de tentación en el desierto, donde será puesto a prueba en su fidelidad a esta identidad recién revelada en el río Jordán. Mateo nos dice que Jesús fue "llevado por el Espíritu al desierto," lo que me parece una santa promesa de que, sin importar dónde nos encontremos, sin importar cuán rápido cambien nuestras circunstancias (desde el bautismo, un momento espiritual elevado, hasta la tentación, un momento difícil y bajo), el Espíritu de Dios nunca se aleja de nuestro lado.

En marcado contraste con la respuesta de Adán y Eva, que cedieron a la tentación del diablo en el relato de la creación, la reacción de Jesús es firme en su fidelidad a vivir solo en la plenitud de la vida que proviene de la unión con Dios. A través de Adán, heredamos el pecado; a través de Jesús, se nos da la libertad y la vida.

La Cuaresma, como tiempo de arrepentimiento, nos impulsa a enfrentarnos a las mismas tentaciones a las que se enfrentó Jesús: la comida, la seguridad y el poder. Nos encontramos con versiones de estas tentaciones constantemente, y la tentación es permitir que ocupen un lugar central en nuestras vidas, donde pueden echar raíces y ocupar en nuestros corazones el espacio que solo se llena y se alimenta verdaderamente cuando nos rendimos a Dios.

## SAN GABRIEL DE NUESTRA SEÑORA DE LOS DOLORES

Santo del día: 21 de febrero

Santo patrón del clero, los estudiantes y los jóvenes

Nacido en Italia en el seno de una familia numerosa y bautizado como Francisco, San Gabriel perdió a su madre cuando solo tenía cuatro años. Fue educado por los jesuitas y, tras curarse dos veces de graves enfermedades, llegó a creer que Dios lo llamaba a la vida religiosa. El joven Francisco deseaba unirse a los jesuitas, pero fue rechazado, probablemente debido a su edad, ya que aún no había cumplido los 17 años. Tras la muerte de una hermana a causa del cólera, su determinación de entrar en la vida religiosa se hizo aún más fuerte y fue aceptado por los pasionistas. Al ingresar en el noviciado, se le dio el nombre de Gabriel de Nuestra Señora de los Dolores.

Siempre popular y alegre, Gabriel pronto tuvo éxito en su esfuerzo por ser fiel en las pequeñas cosas. Su espíritu de oración, su amor por los pobres, su consideración por los sentimientos de los demás, su observancia exacta de la Regla Pasionista, así como sus penitencias corporales —siempre sometido a la voluntad de sus sabios superiores— causaron una profunda impresión en todos.

Sus superiores tenían grandes expectativas puestas en Gabriel mientras se preparaba para el sacerdocio, pero tras solo cuatro años de vida religiosa aparecieron los síntomas de la tuberculosis. Siempre obediente, soportó pacientemente los dolorosos efectos de la enfermedad y las restricciones que esta le imponía, sin buscar ningún trato especial. Murió en paz el 27 de febrero de 1862, a los 24 años, habiendo sido un ejemplo tanto para jóvenes como para mayores.

San Gabriel de Nuestra Señora de los Dolores fue canonizado en 1920.

Cuando pensamos en alcanzar la santidad haciendo pequeñas cosas con amor y gracia, lo primero que nos viene a la mente es Teresa de Lisieux. Al igual que ella, Gabriel murió dolorosamente de tuberculosis. Juntos nos animan a cuidar los pequeños detalles de la vida cotidiana, a ser considerados con los sentimientos de los demás cada día. Nuestro camino hacia la santidad, al igual que el suyo, probablemente no radica en actos heroicos, sino en realizar pequeños actos de bondad cada día.
