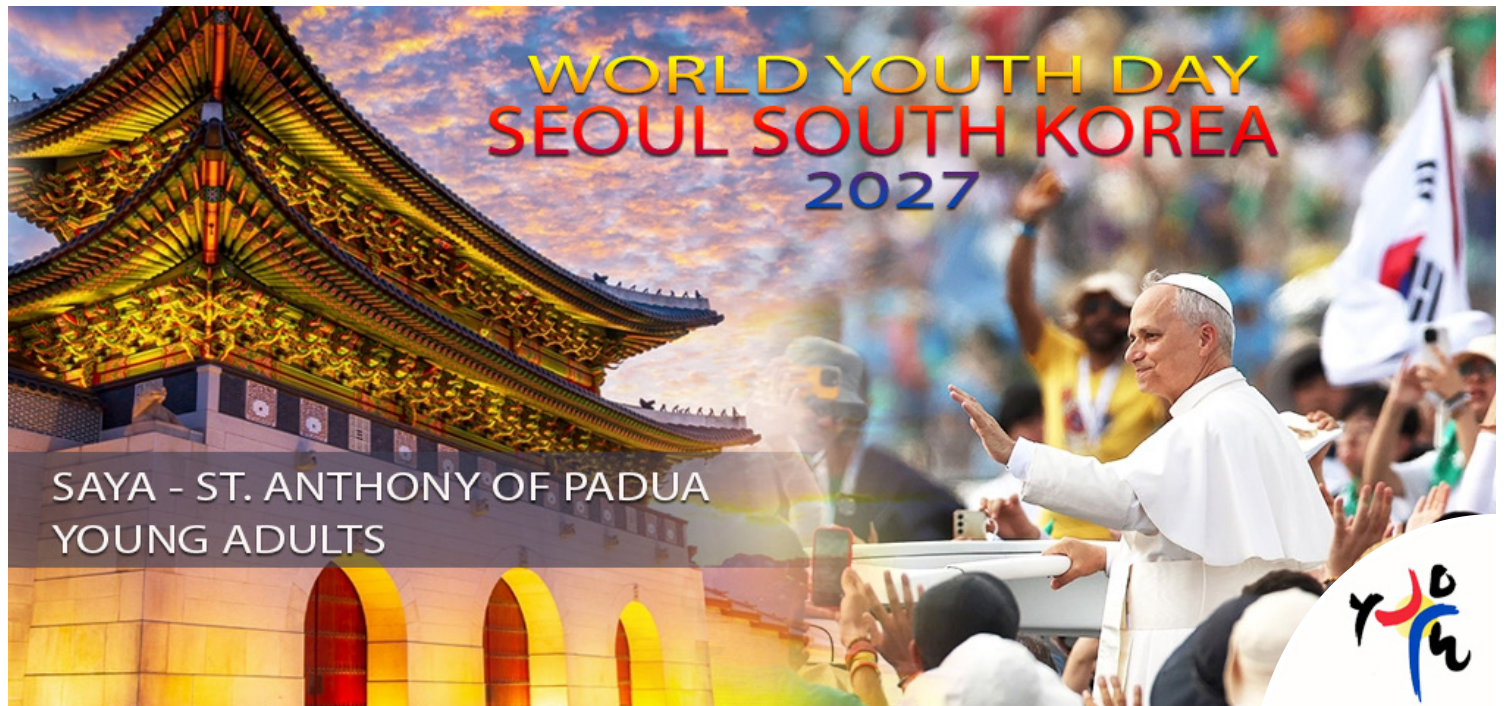

Our **SAYA** (St. Anthony of Padua Young Adults) group will be going to World Youth Day 2027.

This once-in-a-lifetime experience will take place in Seoul, South Korea, from July 27-August 8, 2027, featuring the theme "Take Courage! I have overcome the world" (John 16:33) and expected attendance from Pope Leo XIV.

Pope Francis chose John 16:33 as the theme for World Youth Day Seoul 2027. This verse, spoken by Jesus to His disciples at the Last Supper, reminds us of the irrevocable truth that despite the challenges of the world, Christ has already conquered fear, sin, and death. It is a call to hope and courage rooted in faith in the Resurrection – not a passive optimism, but a bold confidence grounded in the living presence of Christ.

Young people across the globe today are confronted with a wide range of challenges, including conflicts, economic hardship, and an uncertain future. Thankfully, at WYD Seoul 2027, they can receive the joy of becoming the "salt of the earth and the light of the world." Through their encounters with one another they will experience unconditional love, thereby gaining the strength to be sent back out into the world as "pilgrims of hope" and "courageous missionaries," boldly putting into practice the joy of the Gospel they have discovered.

Pope Francis chose Seoul, South Korea, for World Youth Day 2027 to highlight the universality of the Church, engage Asian youth, and support a vibrant minority-Christian community where Catholics are roughly 11% of the population. Seoul, South Korea honors the strong historical roots of Korean martyrs and the active engagement of modern Korean youth.

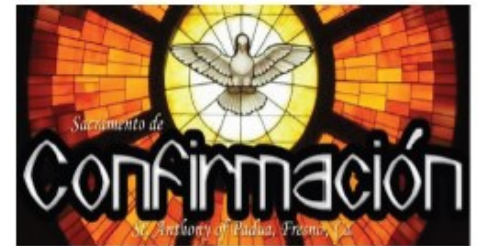

WHO AM I?

Reflection on Matthew 16:13-20

Today's Gospel presents us with one of the central questions of our lives as Jesus asks: "Who do you say that I am?" There are so many answers that one can give: Lord, Savior, friend, teacher, Redeemer, confidant, brother, healer, Son of the Living God, Light of the World, the Christ. At one time or another in our lives, even in the course of any given day, one of these might surface as central in our relationship with Jesus.

Let us also consider that when addressing this question of Jesus' identity, we are also answering the question, "Who am I?" What do I believe? What do I stand for? Where is the North on my compass? What do I place at the center of my life?

When Peter confesses that Jesus is the Christ in answer to the question, Jesus then renames Peter, giving him a new identity and a new purpose. The same can happen to us, if we allow it. Jesus can re-name us, re-direct our passions, give us new understanding, renew in us clean hearts and the desire to follow Him wherever He might lead.

SAINT ROSE OF LIMA

Saint of the Day: August 23

Patron Saint of Americas, Florists and Latin America

Rose of Lima was born to parents of Spanish descent in Lima, Peru, at a time when South America was in its first century of evangelization. She seems to have taken Catherine of Siena as a model, in spite of the objections and ridicule of parents and friends.

The saints have so great a love of God that what seems bizarre to us, and is indeed sometimes imprudent, is simply a logical carrying out of a conviction that anything that might endanger a loving relationship with God must be rooted out. So, because her beauty was so often admired, Rose used to rub her face with pepper to produce disfiguring blotches. Later, she wore a thick circlet of silver on her head, studded on the inside, like a crown of thorns.

When Rose of Lima's parents fell into financial trouble, she worked in the garden all day and sewed at night. They refused to let her enter a convent, and out of obedience she continued her life of penance and solitude at home as a member of the Third Order of Saint Dominic. So deep was her desire to live the life of Christ that she spent most of her time at home in solitude.

During the last few years of her life, Rose of Lima set up a room in the house where she cared for homeless children, the elderly, and the sick. This was a beginning of social services in Peru. Though secluded in life and activity, she was brought to the attention of Inquisition interrogators, who could only say that she was influenced by grace.

What might have been a merely eccentric life was transfigured from the inside. If we remember some unusual penances, we should also remember the greatest thing about Rose of Lima: a love of God so ardent that it withstood ridicule from without, violent temptation, and lengthy periods of sickness. When she died at 31, the city turned out for her funeral. Prominent men took turns carrying her coffin.

¿QUIÉN SOY YO?

Reflexión sobre Mateo 16:13-20

El Evangelio de hoy nos plantea una de las preguntas centrales de nuestras vidas cuando Jesús nos pregunta: "¿Quién dicen que soy yo?" Hay tantas respuestas que uno puede dar: Señor, Salvador, amigo, maestro, Redentor, confidente, hermano, sanador, Hijo del Dios vivo, Luz del mundo, el Cristo. En algún momento de nuestras vidas, incluso en el transcurso de un día cualquiera, alguna de estas respuestas podría surgir como central en nuestra relación con Jesús.

Consideremos también que, al abordar esta pregunta sobre la identidad de Jesús, también estamos respondiendo a la pregunta: "¿Quién soy yo?" ¿En qué creo? ¿Qué defiendo? ¿Dónde está el norte en mi brújula? ¿Qué pongo en el centro de mi vida?

Cuando Pedro confiesa que Jesús es el Cristo en respuesta a la pregunta, Jesús le cambia el nombre a Pedro, dándole una nueva identidad y un nuevo propósito. Lo mismo puede sucedernos a nosotros, si lo permitimos. Jesús puede cambiarnos el nombre, reorientar nuestras pasiones, darnos una nueva comprensión, renovar en nosotros corazones puros y el deseo de seguirlo dondequiera que Él nos lleve.

SANTA ROSA DE LIMA

— Por la J... el día: 23 de agosto

...trona de las Américas, de los floristas y de América Latina

Rosa de Lima nació de padres de ascendencia española en Lima, Perú, en una época en que Sudamérica se encontraba en su primer siglo de evangelización. Al parecer, tomó a Catalina de Siena como modelo, a pesar de las objeciones y las burlas de sus padres y amigos.

Los santos tienen un amor tan grande por Dios que lo que a nosotros nos parece extraño, y que de hecho a veces es imprudente, no es más que la aplicación lógica de la convicción de que todo lo que pueda poner en peligro una relación de amor con Dios debe ser erradicado. Así, debido a que su belleza era admirada con tanta frecuencia, Rosa solía frotarse el rostro con pimienta para producirse manchas que la desfiguraran. Más tarde, usaba en la cabeza una gruesa diadema de plata, tachonada por dentro, como una corona de espinas.

Cuando los padres de Rosa de Lima cayeron en dificultades económicas, ella trabajaba en el jardín todo el día y cosía por las noches. Sus padres se negaron a dejarla ingresar a un convento, y por obediencia continuó su vida de penitencia y soledad en casa como miembro de la Tercera Orden de Santo Domingo. Tan profundo era su deseo de vivir la vida de Cristo que pasaba la mayor parte de su tiempo en casa, en soledad. Durante los últimos años de su vida, Rosa de Lima habitó una habitación en su casa donde atendía a niños sin hogar, a personas mayores y a enfermos. Este fue el inicio de los servicios sociales en Perú. Aunque llevaba una vida y unas actividades apartadas, llamó la atención de los inquisidores, quienes solo pudieron afirmar que estaba influenciada por la gracia.

Lo que podría haber sido una vida meramente excéntrica se transfiguró desde dentro. Si recordamos algunas penitencias inusuales, también debemos recordar lo más importante de Rosa de Lima: un amor a Dios tan ardiente que resistió el ridículo del exterior, las tentaciones violentas y largos períodos de enfermedad. Cuando murió a los 31 años, toda la ciudad acudió a su funeral. Hombres prominentes se turnaron para llevar su ataúd.

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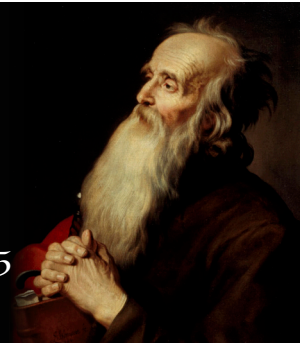

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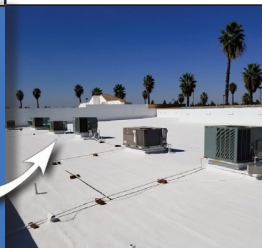


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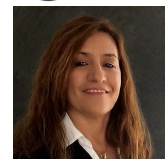

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
